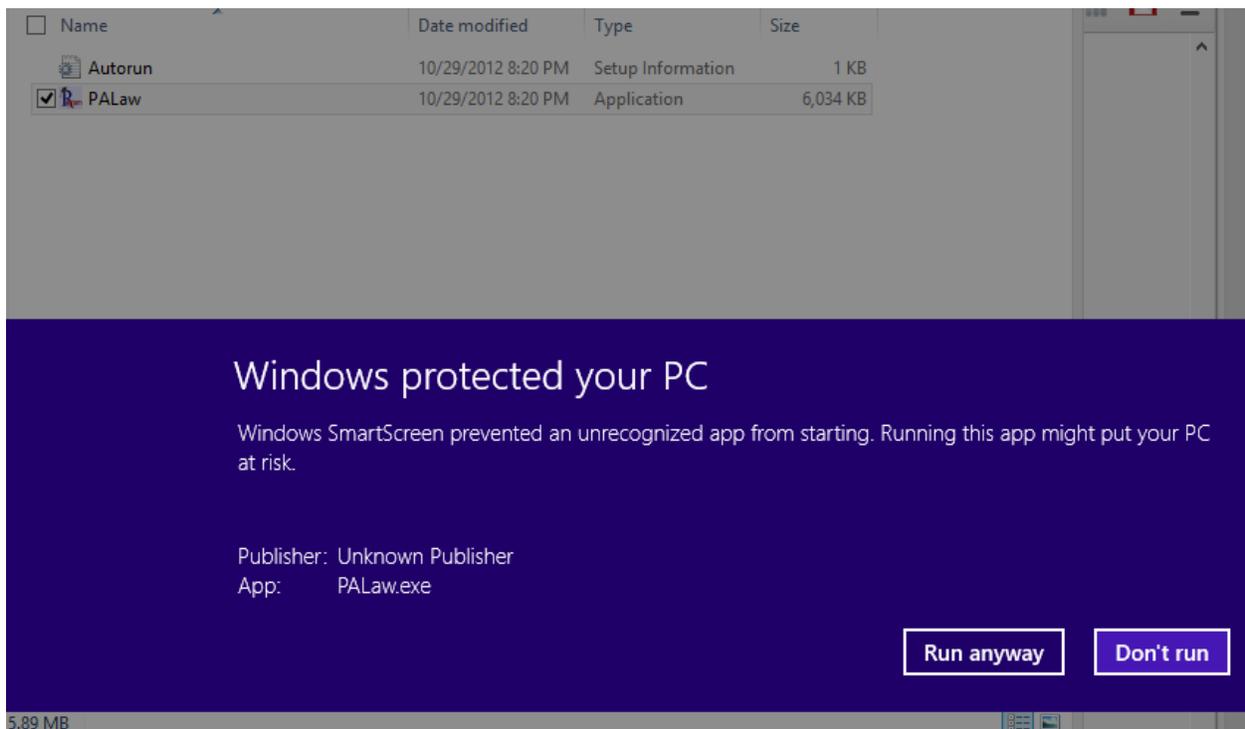
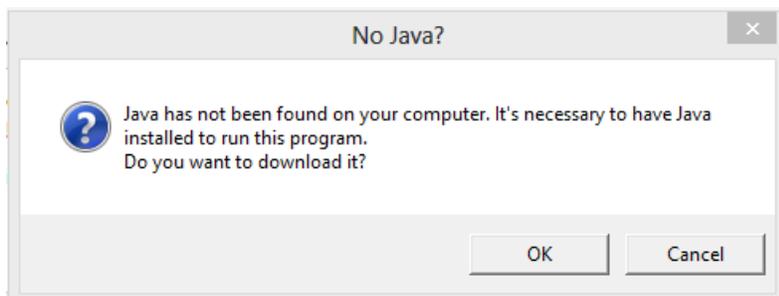


## TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDELINES FOR WINDOW 8 OPERATING SYSTEM

1. When you are using Pharmacy Exam software for First Time on Window 8, you will receive the following message upon clicking “More Info” tab:



2. Please Click “Run Anyway”. Upon clicking you will receive a message that saying “Java Not Found”.
